ESPEN was established 1980 as a multidisciplinary Society devoted to the study of metabolic problems associated with acute diseases and their nutritional implications and management and to publish a journal Clinical Nutrition.

Aims

ESPEN is dedicated to all issues relevant to the field of clinical nutrition and metabolism and promotes:

- **basic and clinical research**
- **basic and advanced education**
- **organization of consensus statements about clinical care and care quality control**

The aims of ESPEN are to encourage the rapid diffusion of knowledge and its application in the field of Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition or, more broadly, Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism.

ESPEN sponsors a journal and for which it assumes editorial, as distinct from publishing, responsibility.

It promotes experimental and clinical research, fosters high ethical standards of practice and investigation, and promotes contact between investigators and clinicians in related fields.

Education - LLL Programme

The Life Long Learning (LLL) programme in Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism is an extremely effective educational programme for ESPEN members offering training on-line and at live courses, by variety of innovative training methodologies and resources.

LLL programme in Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism is based on an Educational curriculum offering 120 training modules (90 are already available on-line) created and peer reviewed by recognized European experts.

Each module consists of updated review on a certain problem, clinical case, self-assessment test and grading quiz. Modules on related subject areas are grouped into Topics making it easier for the user to select modules in a particular field of interest.

Live courses (4-5 per year) provide intensive training and certification. Annual schedule of live courses is announced [here](#) and on [ESPEN website](#).

Credits are awarded at live courses and for on-line training. Participation in a live course on one topic provides 3 CME credits. Each topic taken on-line provides up to 4 CME credits according to activities undertaken. Credit accumulation gives you the opportunity to be awarded the ESPEN Diploma in Clinical Nutrition.
